## **MOORING TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. This permit is non-transferable and is for the use of the vessel listed on Page 1 of this application only, except on a temporary basis and at the discretion of the Long Island Harbormaster. It is illegal to rent a mooring without a federal permit.**
- 2. Location of NEW moorings will be approved by the Long Island Harbormaster.**
- 3. Holder of the mooring permit is responsible for setting the mooring and making adjustments as required for the safety of the vessel named in this application and other adjacent vessels.**
- 4. Mooring permit numbers MUST be painted on the mooring ball (buoy) in at least three (3) inch numbers of contrasting color.**
- 5. The valid mooring permit sticker must be affixed on the port side of the vessel immediately following the state registration sticker.**
- 6. If any boat on a permitted mooring is taking on water or is deemed a hazard or menace to navigation, the Harbormaster may authorize a private contractor to take necessary action to mitigate the situation at the expense of the owner. The owner must pay the contractor within 60 (sixty) days, or he/she will loose mooring privileges.**
- 7. Moorings should be inspected every two (2) years by a qualified mooring inspector.**
- 8. The mooring under this permit must be in the assigned location by June 1<sup>st</sup> of the permit year or its location may be reassigned according to the waiting list priority. Moorings not registered at that time will be considered abandoned, cut loose or removed, and their location reassigned unless prior arrangements have been made with the Harbormaster. Abandoned moorings may be sold for the cost of removal or storage.**
