

## **Minutes of Meeting**

**January 11, 2017**

The meeting was convened at 5:00 PM with a quorum.

Selectmen reviewed the weekly Town Warrants.

The board reviewed its weekly correspondence.

The board reviewed committee openings. There is an opening on the Planning Board.

The board reviewed the minutes of the January 9, 2017 meeting.

- It was Moved (Donovan), Seconded (Watts) and Voted to approve the minutes of the January 09, 2017 meeting. (Motion passed 3-0).

The board met with Dave Singo to discuss the current deer reduction results as well as proposed changes for next year. Dave reported that over 30 deer were taken so far this season. The committee is looking at relocation of one or more of the bait stations.

The board postponed its discussion for the Town's 25th anniversary. Invited representatives from other departments were not available. The board continued its review of town hall staffing in light of the retirement of the Town Clerk/Tax Collector. It was decided to separate the two

positions and fill them with two different people. The board is also looking to fill the Deputy Assistant position.

The board will meet again on January 16, 2017 to continue this process.

The meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM. The next meeting of the Board is January 16, 2017. This will be a special meeting and the board will be in executive session to discuss personnel matters. The next regular meeting of the board is January 18, 2017.
