

Minutes of Meeting

April 05, 2018

Board of Selectmen

Town of Long Island

The meeting was convened at 5:00 PM with a quorum.

Selectmen reviewed the weekly Town Warrants.

The board reviewed the minutes of the March 29, 2018 meeting.

- It was Moved (Donovan), Seconded (Harmon) and Voted to approve the minutes of the March 29, 2018 meeting. (Motion passed 3-0).

The board reviewed its weekly correspondence.

The board reviewed vacancies. There is still one opening on Planning Board. There is also an opening for an Animal Control Officer.

Mark Greene met with the board to discuss the status of the town-owned Lot #175 in the Red Sands sub-division. The abutting owners have requested that the lot be given to them based on research at the Registry of Deeds Office indicating original ownership of the lot in question. The board discussed the possibility of offering the lot for sale. Mark Greene is doing some additional research on the issue.

The board met with Amy Tierney, Town Clerk, to review the final draft of the annual town report, including a review of financials and revisions to town hall hours.

Brian briefed the board on the return of the Code Enforcement Officer; the status of the Boiler Building demolition; and, the construction of the Wellness Center.

Brian will reach out to another coordinator from the Swim Run event to see if that will still happen this year.

The board continued its discussion on the budget and the CIP program.
