Cost of the removal will be billed to the last known owner. In addition, a \$100.00 administration fee may be charged. I hereby declare the information provided is to the best of my knowledge correct and complete. False information may result in the loss of privileges. ## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. This permit is non-transferable and is for the use of the vessel listed on the front side of this application, except on a temporary basis at the discretion of the Long Island Harbormaster. **It is illegal to rent a mooring without a federal permit.**
2. Locations of new moorings will be approved by the Long Island Harbormaster.
3. Holder of the mooring permit is responsible for setting the mooring and making all adjustments as required for the safety of the vessel named in the application and other adjacent vessels.
4. Mooring permit number **MUST** be visible on the mooring ball. Numbers must be at least 3 inches high and of a contrasting color. If mooring ball is not properly marked, the mooring will be declared non-compliant and may be removed at the direction of the Long Island Harbor Master. Removed, non-compliant moorings may be sold for the cost of the removal and storage.
5. The valid mooring permit sticker must be affixed on the port side of the vessel immediately following the state registration number on the port bow. In the case of a federally documented vessel, the sticker will be affixed on the port bow.
6. If any vessel on a permitted mooring is taking on water, deemed a hazard or menace to navigation, the Long Island Harbor Master may authorize a private contractor to take necessary action to mitigate the situation at the expense of the owner. The owner must pay the contractor within sixty (60) days, or the mooring privileges may be revoked.
7. Moorings should be inspected every two (2) years.
8. The mooring under this permit must be in the assigned location by June 1<sup>st</sup> of the permit year or the location may be reassigned according to the waiting list priority. Moorings not registered at that time will be considered abandoned and may be removed and the location reassigned, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Long Island Harbormaster. Abandoned moorings may be sold for the cost of removal and storage.

These terms and conditions are not complete or comprehensive. Refer to the Town of Long Island ordinances for full listings.
