RETURNING TO LONG ISLAND FROM OUT OF STATE (Statement from the Office of Governor Janet Mills)

Governor Mills issued an Executive Order mandating that travelers arriving in Maine, regardless of their state of residency, self-quarantine for a minimum of 14 days to mitigate the spread of Covid 19.

While the Governor hopes that compliance with this order will be voluntary, it may also be enforced by law enforcement, as necessary.
