

Minutes of Meeting

September 27, 2018

Board of Selectmen

Town of Long Island

Present: Chair, Joe Donovan, Selectmen Marie Harmon, Paul Watts; Town Administrator, Brian Dudley.

The meeting was convened at 5:00 PM with a quorum.

Selectmen reviewed the weekly Town Warrants.

The board reviewed the minutes of the meetings of September 20, 2018.

- It was Moved (Donovan), Seconded (Watts) and Voted to approve the minutes of the meeting of September 20, 2018. (Motion passed 3-0).

The board met with Penny Murley regarding placing a storage shed up at the Community Garden for the storage of equipment and supplies.

The board reviewed its weekly correspondence. There was a follow up inquiry regarding the schedule for the review of paper streets. The board has not set a schedule yet. It is starting with the Littlejohn subdivision on October the 18th. This is only a beginning of the review. No votes or final decisions will be made.

Notices to owners of lots within each sub-division will be sent in advance of their initial meeting.

Brian briefed the board on several building permit issues that he had reviewed with the Town Code Enforcement Officer. The board will meet with the Town's attorney to review ordinance language and on-going violations.

The building permit has been revised to require the placement of a dumpster for all commercial demolition and/or building projects.

The board met with Ed McAleney on some road maintenance issues as well as for an update on the Zoning Board of Appeals.

The board discussed the process for the replacement of the ambulance. It is hoped that the Long Island Fire & Rescue Association can coordinate the fundraising.

Brian updated the board on the Rapid Renewal program for vehicle re-registrations. Brian will set up a meeting with that agency to discuss implementation on Long Island.

The meeting adjourned 7:05 PM. The next regular meeting of the Board is October 04, 2018.
