

Minutes of Meeting

June 27, 2019

Board of Selectmen

Town of Long Island

Present: Chair, Joe Donovan and Selectmen John Burke & Marie Harmon;
Brian Dudley, Town Administrator.

The meeting was convened at 5:00 PM with a quorum.

Selectmen reviewed the weekly Town Warrants.

The board reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting.

- It was Moved (Donovan), Seconded (Harmon) and Voted to approve the minutes of the meeting of June 20, 2019. (Motion passed 3-0).

The board reviewed the status of the new parking signs for down front. A draft of the sign displays will be sent out for review. Parking is a difficult issue as there are 540 permits issued and there are only 135 spaces total available. The annual town meeting in 2018 rejected funding for an upper Island Avenue lot expansion to help relieve the parking congestion. The board continues to encourage people to find alternatives to leaving their vehicles down front.

The board reviewed the status of the tree that washed up during a storm a few weeks ago. It is temporarily tied off at Mariners Wharf until it can be towed away.

Brian has asked Baker Engineering to review the repairs needed for Ponces Landing.

The board reviewed the 2019-2020 insurance policy renewal offering. The board opted for a higher deductible to reduce the premium cost.

The board asked the Town Clerk for an update on the outstanding Food Service Establishment licenses. No additional information has been received.

The board reviewed the land use issues at Apple Lane. The matter was referred to the Code Enforcement Officer.
