

## **Minutes of Meeting**

**August 29, 2019**

### **Board of Selectmen**

### **Town of Long Island**

Present: Chair, Joe Donovan and Selectmen John Burke & Marie Harmon; Brian Dudley, Town Administrator.

The meeting was convened at 5:00 PM with a quorum.

Selectmen reviewed the weekly Town Warrants.

The board reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting.

- It was Moved (Harmon), Seconded (Donovan) and Voted to approve the minutes of the meeting of August 29, 2019. (Motion passed 3-0).

The board welcomed Doug McCowen, a new property owner on Long Island, to the board meeting as a public observer.

The board reviewed correspondence received. There was a communication on skateboarders using the new tennis and pickleball courts. The Town asks that all residents stop using skateboards, rollerblading or riding bicycle/scooters on the courts.

The board discussed abandoned vehicles on the island. Another abandoned vehicle removal is planned for the fall. The town will notify the last known registered owner of any vehicle that the town will have removed to the mainland.

The board discussed the fall hours of the Transfer Station. They will be the same as last year. The board will be reviewing possible changes in hours of operation for all four seasons. Any public input is welcome ([townadmin@longisland.org](mailto:townadmin@longisland.org))

The trash truck will be going into town for servicing.

The board met with Katie Norton to review recreation programs. Katie says that they expect to meet their budgeted revenue goals from the summer programs. Some outstanding recreation program fees are expected this month.

The board stressed the importance of documentation of hours for all recreation programs. Katie will forward a detailed spreadsheet for use in preparing the FY21 budget.

The board met with Andrew Card and Kitty Kiefer to discuss liability issues for public use of beaches and rock outcroppings.

Brian updated the board on:

- 1) The paving schedule. Staging of the cold mix is done. Paving is scheduled to start on Wednesday, September the 11th.
- 2) Brian has issued the RFP for the installation of heat pumps in the school.
- 3) Brian noted the need to vote on the hunting discharge permits. That will be done on September the 5th.
